

Getting Connected to Your Coug Device

Welcome to your internet-connected Light The Coug device! To start lighting up your own personal Coug and keeping track of when the Cougs win, you need to get your device connected to the internet. This happens as a two step process: (1) connect directly to the device to set the SSID and password of your wireless access point and (2) make sure your device is connected to your home wireless network.

WIRELESS

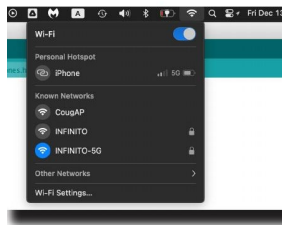
WEP · WPA · WPA2 Personal · Open networks (*WPA2 Enterprise not supported*)

1 Connect to your device

If your device is not connected to a wireless router, it will display **solid yellow lights** at startup.

Open your wireless preferences and connect to the access point named

CougAP



2 Enter WiFi credentials

After connecting wirelessly directly to your device, a window will automatically open that asks you to specify the SSID and password (if needed) of your wireless router.

Your device will then reboot.



3 Open the web interface

When your device reboots, it will **blink red and white** for 2 seconds if it connected successfully to your wireless router.

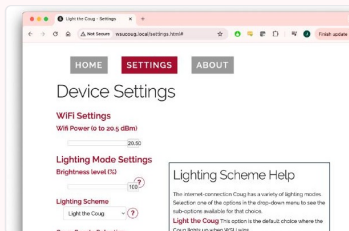
If your router supports mDNS (most do), open this address in any browser on the same network:

<http://WSUCoug.local>

Otherwise, log into your router, find its connected devices list, and enter your device's IP address in your browser.

NOTES & TROUBLESHOOTING

If you ever change your wireless router password, you will need to repeat Steps 1-3 to reconnect your device.



IN THE WEB INTERFACE

You can control many options like:

- Timezone
- Mode of operation
- On/off times
- Brightness & lighting scheme
- Coug sports selection
